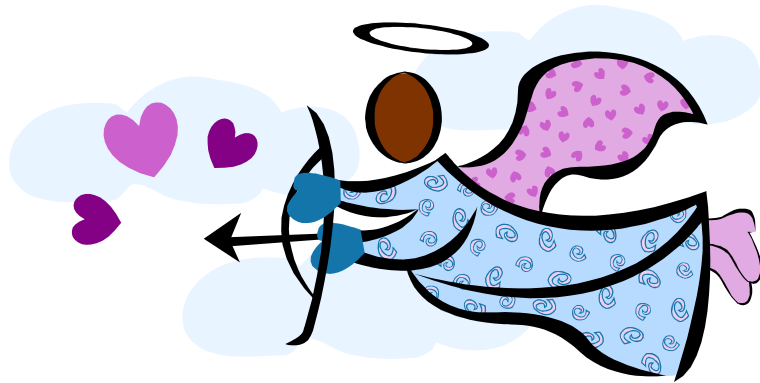


Fort Hill Presbyterian Church Preschool Newsletter February 2010



PARENTS' NOTES:

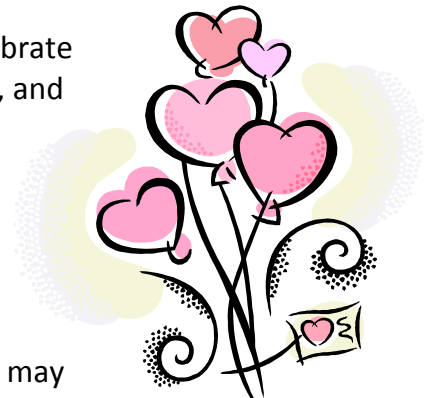
- ☺ There will be NO SCHOOL February 15th, for the Presidents' Day holiday. We will return to school Tuesday, February 16th.

THREE YEAR OLDS: Nelson/Reid/Harrell

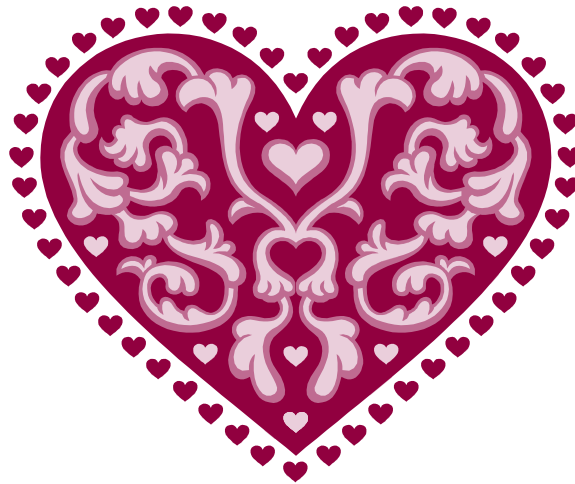
