PARENTS' NOTES:

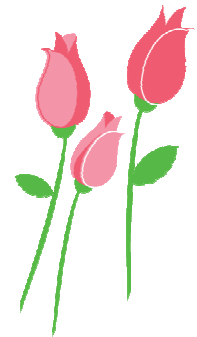
- ☺ Acceptance letters for 2010-2011 classes will be going home the week of March 1. Please check your child's backpack.
