Dear Member of Fort Hill Presbyterian Church,

In the next few weeks, we hope you can find some quiet time to prayerfully consider how *you can use the gifts God has given you to do the work He is calling you to do.*

This service stewardship package contains several documents:

- One or more Service Commitment forms - Each adult member should use a form to offer their service commitments to Fort Hill. Please complete it, *even if you are unable to serve at this time*, and return it in the envelope provided. Your Ministers and Deacon want to know you better and the church seeks to identify new opportunities for fellowship and ministry.
- Booklet entitled Opportunities to Serve - 2010 - This booklet describes the missions, activities and service opportunities for each of our twelve ministry areas. Use this booklet now to learn more about Fort Hill's ministries and, then, keep it for reference throughout the year. Begin by first reading the information on page 3.
- If there are youth members of your household, then you will find a service commitment form designed especially for them. The form contains instructions for its completion. Return it in the envelope provided for your family.

When we receive your service commitment, we will enter the data in the Fort Hill church database. The Elder of each ministry area in which you express an interest (and your Deacon) will receive a report of your service commitment information. Then, you ***will be contacted*** by someone from the ministry areas in which you expressed an interest to discuss the opportunities and decide how you can best serve in the ministry. ***If*** you have not had the opportunity to serve at Fort Hill, your Deacon will call to discuss your commitments and interests and, then, act as ombudsman for you with the ministry area leaders.
